PRODUCTION TYPE AND PARTICULARS

- Stage width 12 m / depth 9 m / height 7 m.
- We need fly bars.
- We need a complete black-out.
- In some venues there may be seats with restricted view, we will draw the sight lines on the adapted plot to your venue.
- The set is transported in a 20 m3 truck, the theater must provide a parking space.
- The theater must provide transportation aids, trolleys and pallet truck for loading an unloading.

TIMES

- Show duration: 1h10 without intermission.
- Technical get-in 16 hours before the cue to cue.
- Cue to cue before the show: 4 hours
- Load-out / Get-out : 3 hours

SCHEDULE

- Pre-rig of light, sound ,curtains and borders before our arrival, according to the plot send by us and adapted to your venue. Pre-rig is mandatory.
- D-1: Load-in 12 hours, arrival of the set at 9 am
- Day of the show : video focus, sound check and side lights focus / cue to cue / performance
- Load-out: after the last performance.

STAGE

Our set:

- 4 walls on wheels, width 1 m, depth 0.5 m, height 2,70 m.
- 4 small painted wood boxes on wheels
- Puppets, various size, stored in 4 alloy boxes.
- We provide the track system.
- 2 black scrim + top cord operation track.
- Lots of props.

The theater must provide:

- Black dance floor if the stage floor is not black.
- 4 tables for props backstage.
- 2 clothes racks backstage.
- Legs and borders according to the light plot.
- 1 back drop.
- 2 curtains german masking according to the light plot.
- Dance floor tapes, mat gaffer tapes, 1meter of light tape to put marks on the floor.

LIGHT

We need a complete black out and clean profiles, we make top hat with black foil for the profiles, we use side lights without flare to focus on the puppet without seeing the puppeteers.

The theater must provide:

- $8 \times 1 \text{ kW profile } 28^{\circ}/54^{\circ} \text{ as Robert Juliat } 614SX$
- $^-$ 17 x 1 kW profile 16°/35° as Robert Julia 613SX
- 1 x PAR CP62
- 5 x PAR CP 60
- 2 x PC 2 kW
- 12x PC 1 kW
- Blackwrap tape
- Black foil

Gels:

- L501, L711, R119.

VIDEO

The theater must provide:

- A video projector 12000 Lumens, HD, 0.8 lens, laser, contrast 10000:1. As a Panasonic PT-RZ970B
- VP position according to light plot.
- Remote controlled shutter.
- HDMI link between our computer and the VP or HDBT beyond 10 meters.

SOUND

PA system:

- FOH L/R + Sub LR (mono)
- 2 speakers stereo upstage on stand.
- 2 speakers stereo Surround.
- 1 digital mixing desk.

The theater must provide:

- 1 x wireless black mics DPA 4080 with body packs and receivers + clamp.
- 5 XLR to connect our sound card.

We bring:

- 2 MacBook Pro with Ableton 10
- 1 sound card

WARDROBE / COSTUMES

Costumes:

- Costumes maintenance during set-up, a night of drying before the show.
- Costumes maintenance after the show.
- Maintenance : wash at 30 °, no dryer. Only returned, dried and deodorized for coats, pants and capes.

<u>Dressing rooms</u>:

- 3 dressing rooms : 3 actresses / 2 actors / 2 technicians
- Changing room must be clean and heated, warm showers, towels, etc...

Catering: Water, fruits, juices, salt food, etc...
